

The Communion


Blessed are you, Lord God of all creation; through your goodness we have this bread to offer, which earth has given and human hands have made: it will become for us the bread of life.

You are worth all our pain and all our praise. So now, in gratitude, we join our voices to those of the Church on earth and in heaven:












Holy, holy, holy Lord.



O Lamb of God, you take away the sins of the world have mercy on us.


