All the colours of the rainbow are welcome! Starting with red

You are invited to fold an angel to remember a moment from the crazy few years we are living in.

You could also remember a person, a hope, or choose to write a prayer. All these personal moments will then be suspended to create a piece of community art in the run up to Christmas

Or if you prefer, simply use the act of folding or cutting out an angel to think through what we have experienced and what you hope for the future.



Fold square of paper in half, Bring sides together, Fold the valleys in corner to corner twice



making valleys



and make triangle

Repeat



Flatten and crease folds



Take a corner and fold it down



Repeat



Fold up






Tuck both into little "pocket"



Fold corner of triangle up and accross. Turn over and do the same on the other side. Lay flat



Turn over. Fold core in half down the middle



Open up and tuck the edge marked in blue along the middle fold, making wings







Open out the broad base to make your angel stand up. Make a paperclip hook to make it fly! Get it to St Johns and we will hang it for you. Together we can make a wonderful rainbow.
